4. What words or phrases stand out or strike you as odd in this passage?
5. Why do you think Jesus chose to walk on the water?
6. What do you think Jesus "intended to pass by them" means? What options are there?
7. How does knowledge from the Old Testament help us understand what's going on in this demonstration? (Job 9:1-11, Job 38:16-18, Psalm 77:18-20, Isaiah 43:16-17, Exodus 33:19-34:8, I Kings 19:11-12)
8. How is this passage an encouragement to you?
9. How is this passage a warning?
10. Respond to the quote from C.S. Lewis - "Christianity, if false, is of no importance; if true, of utmost importance. The only thing it cannot be is moderately important."
11. In what ways do you need to live differently, knowing Jesus is bigger than your boat?
