

# Unit 10: King Saul

**Unit Description:** When God's people wanted a king to be like the nations around them, God warned them but gave them what they wanted. 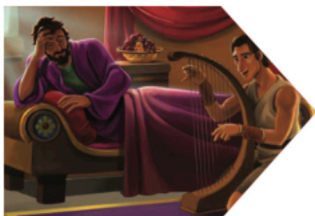
