For *PARTNERSHIP: Partnering with Jesus*

2 Peter 1:1-11

1. Pastor David contrasts the modern idea of “fellowship” (e.g., casual gatherings) with the biblical concept of *koinonia* as a deep, purposeful partnership. How does this deeper understanding of *koinonia* challenge or expand your view of what believers enjoy with other believers?
2. Surprisingly, believers have *koinonia* with the Triune God through Jesus’ work. How does this reality impact the way you view your relationship with God, and what might it look like to live out this divine partnership?
3. According to 2 Peter 1:5-7, believers are called to “make every effort” to supplement their faith with virtues like goodness, knowledge, and love. What does it mean to you to actively participate in your spiritual growth, and how can we avoid the mindset of trying to “earn” salvation through these efforts?
4. Christians have changed kingdoms. What are some “Kingdom values” or behaviors you find challenging to adopt, and how can your church community support you in this process?
5. Spiritual exercises like Word, prayer, fasting, Sabbath, and silence & solitude are ways for us to partner with Jesus. Which of these practices do you currently engage in, and which new practice might you consider adopting to deepen your spiritual life over the next few months? How will you intentionally partner with Jesus and other believers in your spiritual journey, and how can the church help you stay accountable?
